

## Course Description

This course is a one-day hands-on laparoscopic colon surgery course designed for practicing surgeons or post-graduate fellows who are interested in gaining practical experience.

The course consists of brief instructions and discussion followed by a hands-on laboratory session. During the laboratory session, participants will perform a fully laparoscopic right colectomy and left colectomy using fresh cadavers under the guidance of the faculty.

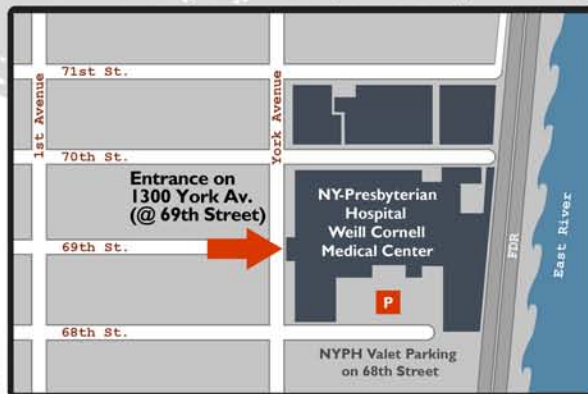
